Held in the Single Brother's House in Old Salem, the Tea includes singing carols, enjoying lovefeast coffee and Moravian sugarcake, watching as beeswax candles are made by hand, and viewing the putz. a replica in miniature of the town of Salem more than a century ago, and a Nativity scene as the Christmas story is read from Scripture.

Admission is \$5 for adults and \$1 for children 12 and under. All proceeds, after expenses, are distributed to non-profit local and international agencies.

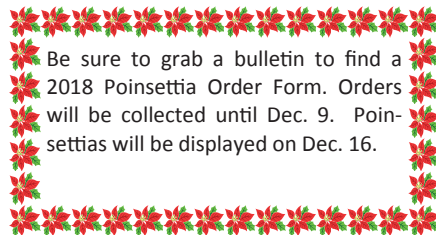
