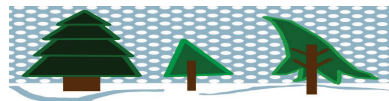

## Advent's History

At the close of 1931, Advent had 201 communicants, 79 children, for a total of 280 (*Wachovia Moravian*, January, 1932, p. 2)

The Christmas season began at Advent on December 13 with a lovefeast with the largest attendance in many years. After all had been served, only 2 buns remained. Mr. and Mrs. B. C. Snyder presented their baby girl, Berletta Gray, to the lord in Holy Baptism at the opening of the service. The following members were received as communicant members: Mr. and Mrs. Curtis Pope, Mr. and Mrs. Linnie Sides, John Shelton, Mrs. Ervin Ebert, Mr. and Mrs. Henry Bullard, Emory Spach, and Kenneth Miller. The Primary Department, consisting of 80 members, rendered their program of songs and recitations under the direction of Mrs. Clyde Gobble on Sunday morning Dec. 20<sup>th</sup>. Christmas Eve was observed with the Moravian candle service and the pageant, "The Messiah Comes," given by the members of the Adult Department. The church was crowded to capacity. The "White Gifts" feature was used this year, and our gifts for the retired missionaries amounted to \$100.00. We are glad to report that our quota of \$150.00 for this cause has been raised. Mrs. James Brewer entertained the Ladies Auxiliary at her home, at which time the Christmas candles were prepared. Cottage prayer meetings were held at the homes of James Krites, P. W. Mock, and Roy Snyder. Members of the young men and young women's Bible classes presented the play, "The Patch across the Hills," at Griffith School on the night of the 10<sup>th</sup>.
