One in four Americans over 65 fall each year, and falls are the leading cause of fatal and nonfatal injuries among this group. Fall injuries are costly too, \$34 billion. While falls are common and costly, the good news is that falls are preventable and not an inevitable part of aging. Programs such as the evidence-based fall prevention program, A Matter of Balance, is a structured group intervention that implements strategies to reduce the fear of falling and increase activity levels among participants.
