Advent's Watchword for 2019

Proverbs 2:6 - "For the Lord gives wisdom; from His mouth comes knowledge and understanding." The supplemental text is a devotional text that we all can apply to ourselves as God's promise for us as well. Psalm 23:6 - "Surely Your goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life, I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever."



Sunday, April 28th at 9am we will continue to share in the past, to prepare for Advent's 95th Anniversary Homecoming celebration in June. Please join us in the Fellowship Center for coffee, punch and snacks before Sunday School. There will be a matching game (details to be announced the week prior) and the winners will be eligible to receive a small book of church history photos.

We need your memories of Advent for 95th Homecoming Celebration. Please give them to Charles Krites or Bob Snyder no later than June 1. These memories will be recorded for all to read.

If you have pictures of Advent or your family that you want to share on Anniversary Sunday, we need the pictures by June 1. We will copy your pictures and return the originals to you. Give your pictures to any member of the Anniversary Committee.

Peggy Sumner discovered the following information while contacting former Advent ministers about Anniversary Sunday. The Rev. Paul A. Snider, Minister of Advent from 1953 to 1957, passed away in December of 2017 at the age of 91. He was living in Nashville, Tennessee and was a minister in the Presbyterian Church.

Summary of the Joint Board Retreat for January 12, 2019

The meeting was called to order with 14 board members present. The devotions were shared by Pastor Tim and Brother Rick Gardin which came from Ephesians chapter 5 and summarized the church as the bride of Christ.

The board members were then divided into four groups for discussion:

Group One - Spread of the Gospel: They discussed that outreach styles have changed and neighborhood visitation may not be as effective as in the past. Revivals are more effective for renewal of members than bringing in new members. More success may be found in one on one witnessing and developing a relationship with the newcomers. We need to pray for the opportunity to witness and for guidance on when it is appropriate.

Group Two – Worship and Glorify God: We worship through serving. Members should choose and be willing to serve because it is a privilege. Board members should set an example for others to follow. The board needs the prayers of the congregation on a continual basis.

Group Three – Support the Membership: The Board of Elders should follow up on their assigned Shepherd's List. Pictures of new members should be posted on bulletin board so that the current members can become more familiar with them. Prepare and deliver meals to shut ins and members who are in need. Using the Church Directory or the Shepherd's List, invite members to consider helping in areas that they are not currently involved with in a loving and caring way. If you know of any contact information changes please let the Membership Committee and the office know. Pray for the membership.

Group Four – Reflecting Christ in the Community: Be ambassadors for the church in the community. Greeters need to be more intentional in their welcome to guests as well as members. Could we develop or work with more community programs such as an after-school program or service? Could we use the church van and assist people in getting to church or as a ministry? Are we reflecting God on a personal level in our interactions and are we showing love and mercy in our daily walk?

After discussion of our respective groups the Church Council Minutes for 2018 were approved. The Worship Calendar was approved. The Committee Lists were discussed and finalized. A general discussion was held concerning the use of Social Media by the church as a tool for information and outreach. Rick Gardin made the motion to hand over the prospect of having a Facebook account for the church to the Communications Committee for review. Bob Snyder seconded it and the motion was approved. Carole Long is the chair of the committee and will proceed per the boards instructions.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:00 PM
