Film Screening/Discussion

The Moravian Team for Racial, Ethnic, and Cultural Reconciliation will host a free screening of the feature film **The Best of Enemies**, followed by a small group discussion forum reflecting on how we can bridge the racial divides that are so evident today. Based on the book by the same name, it is the true story of how a black activist and a KKK leader became firm friends and transformed school desegregation in Durham, NC. Interviews with the real-life Ann Atwater and C. P. Ellis were featured in a 2002 documentary called *An Unlikely Friendship*, where the two told their story of how their lives were changed through working together. The story models how a process that brings divided people to the same table can build relationships that overcome the barriers of hate and fear.

Starring Taraji P. Henson as Ann Atwater, (a civil rights activist in Durham) and Sam Rockwell as C. P. Ellis (Grand Wizard of the Durham KKK). Special thanks to STX Films for special permission to hold and promote the screening.

From the Pastor...

Be Still and Hear

When we think of our personal Spiritual growth as believers, what comes to mind? There are three that come to me automatically: our prayer life, our reading of God's word and the association of believers. However, for the sake of this article I would like to talk about our prayer life and specifically one type of praying. We have prayers of intercession, confession, thanksgiving and praise, and in performing these prayers we talk to God. These are all important and necessary for Spiritual growth and should be done continually. However, there is another way to pray that I think may be done less often and it is Contemplative prayer.

Contemplative prayer is when we allow the Holy Spirit to speak to us as we remain silent. A way to begin is that we acknowledge our thankfulness for all the blessings that God has bestowed upon us and then proceed into a time of silence. The difficult part is to be still and listen to the Spirit's leading. In today's society we are so driven by goals and schedules and immediate results of information that we find this task outside the norm. Often times our minds will want to wander, but with some practice and discipline this gets better. As the Psalmist wrote, *NKJ Psalm 46:10 Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth!* If Contemplative Prayer is not a part of your prayer life, give it a try. I am sure you will be blessed by it.
